## **Mrs. Scott's 5/6 Class Supply List**

***NOTICE: The things under "Student Items" will be used in class. Parents may choose to buy some or all of these items. Anything their child does not have on this list will be furnished by the school.***

### **CREW - student items (for personal use):**

- 1 regular tipped, black permanent marker
- 4 pencils, with good erasers
- plug-in headphones - must be visible; NO earbuds or airpods please
- computer mouse with cord - OPTIONAL
- combination lock for locker (keys with locks tend to get lost) - OPTIONAL
- water bottle - to be left at school
  - please send water bottles that are well-balanced, that will not tip over easily

### **WRITING CLASS - student items (for personal use):**

- 2 highlighters - different colors
- 1 colored pen, for correcting/editing (NOT blue or black)
- 4 small glue sticks

### **Class-Use donation items:**

- kleenexes
- 1 container of disinfectant wipes (the kind that comes in a hard container, not a package)
- 1 pkg. Ticonderoga pencils
- regular-sized Expo (dry erase) markers
- fine-tipped black Expo (dry erase) markers
- post-its/sticky notes, (about 3"x3" in size)
- permanent markers

- pkg. blue or black ink pens
- small glue sticks
- any crafting items for Mrs. Cornelius's club (to be taken to her classroom)

### **Please note:**

- If your child brings a cell phone or wireless earbuds to school, they need to plan on leaving it in their locker DURING school. This includes recess and lunch break. School starts at 8:20 and ends at 3:00. Students who bring cell phones or wireless earbuds into class will have them taken away. They may talk to me and pick them up after school. If your child has a cell phone or wireless earbuds, please talk to them about these expectations.
- Smart watches are allowed as long as they are ONLY used to tell time - nothing else. (We find that smart watches are a big distraction for a lot of students, and some use them to find answers and cheat.)
- **PLEASE** write your child's name on all their belongings, including backpacks, lunch boxes, coats, headphones, computer mice, etc.
- While toys are not strictly forbidden at school, we ask that you PLEASE encourage your child to leave them at home. Toys distract from learning, and they can get lost, damaged, or stolen. PLEASE leave them at home.
- If your child has special needs of any kind - special diet, difficulty seeing, fidgets a lot, needs a comfort object, etc.), **please** let me know. I want your child to feel safe and comfortable in my classroom.

**For PERSONAL use— please LABEL with student name!**

Recommended:

- For writing class: red pen, 4 glue sticks, 2 different color highlighters
- Water bottle - to be left in lockers
- Plug-in headphones (not Bluetooth)
- Computer mouse, labeled WITH a cord (lots of lost dongles)
- Locker organizer (OPTIONAL: personal supplies will be kept in lockers)

**For CLASS use— do NOT label**

NEEDED:

- Kleenex tissues**
- Clorox or Lysol wipes**
- Rubber cement glue**
- Colored printer paper
- Regular or Fine tip Expo markers

REQUESTED:

- Ticonderoga pencils
- Colored/metallic sharpies
- Ultra fine NON-bleed black sharpies
- Ziploc bags and/or aluminum foil
- Any craft supplies and building materials for our makerspace
  - hot glue sticks (small diameter), rubber cement, gorilla glue, super glue
  - plastic and foam: plates, cups, trays, balls, containers, etc
  - fabric, needles, pins, thread, embroidery floss, embroidery hoops
  - cotton balls, pom poms, pipe cleaners, wire
  - tape - any kind, but especially duct or packaging
  - polymer oven-bake clay (like Sculpey & Fimo)
  - shoe boxes, stiff cardboard rolls, other fun cardboard shapes/containers
  - diamond art, Perler beads, jewelry making supplies
  - craft wood of various shapes & sizes, woodworking scraps/trim
- Any items that would could be sold to students in a teacher store or auction:
  - fidgets

  - random fun items/small gift cards, etc
